



It is resistant to liquid contamination such as wet floors, liquid accidentally placed inside the box or rain from outside storage.

Our Griff Carton is manufactured from 75% recycled cardboard and designed to be used within a hospital environment in place of a rigid plastic container where appropriate. It uses a double bag system with a plastic inner bag that is tied off and a cardboard box outer to create the second protective layer. Due to infection control we would not recommend using these in a Theatre or Intensive Care Unit.
